SHOW SYNOPSIS:

Based on the famous novel by Roald Dahl, *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* features an original score composed by Marc Shaiman with lyrics by Shaiman and Scott Wittman (*Hairspray*) and a book by David Greig. The score also pays homage to the Leslie Bricusse/Anthony Newley score from the 1971 film with songs from the motion picture including "Candy Man," "I've Got a Golden Ticket," "Oompa Loompa Song," and "Pure Imagination."

The world-famous Willy Wonka is opening the gates to his mysterious factory...but only to a lucky few. Young Charlie Bucket and four other golden ticket winners will embark on a life-changing journey through Wonka's world

of pure imagination including chocolate waterfalls, nutty squirrels and the great glass elevator, all to be revealed by Wonka's army of curious Oompa-Loompas.

AUDITION DETAILS

We are looking for the following:

Kids: 5 named roles + 4-5 ensemble. age 10 - 14 Veruca Salt must be a dancer Adult - 6 named, 4 Mature (grandparents), (10 adults)

As part of Marquee's commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion, we make intentional choices to ensure we are a welcoming space for people of all ethnicities, economic status, sexual orientation, and gender identity. We encourage submissions from artists of all backgrounds, lived experiences, ages and gender identities.

What to prepare

- 1) Prepare upbeat Broadway/Musical Theatre song, contemporary style showcasing your range using a backing track, best 32 bars/1 min max.
- 2) Monologue dramatic or comedic max 1 minute must be memorized
- 3) Group dance audition wear comfortable clothing and indoor shoes
- Those being considered for the named kids roles will be called back for additional dance audition - only for the kids.

Headshot and Performance Resume is also required.

DANCE - nothing to prepare as this will be taught by our choreographer

Please be sure to wear proper, comfortable clothing and shoes for the dance audition (no bare feet, socks or flip flops). Bring indoor shoes for our dance floor (no outdoor shoes permitted on this floor).

AUDITION REQUIREMENT:

- 1 song
- Pre-recorded tracks are required (we can play from your device)
- 1 min comedic monologue
- Everyone will be required to participate in a group dance call (this will all be scheduled on the same day)
- There will not be a live accompanist present please bring a backing track on your device. We will have audio cords for android and iPhones/tablets available to play through our sound system.
- Headshot and performance resume

ABOUT THE COMPANY/EXPECTATIONS

Marquee Theatrical Productions was founded in 2003 and is an award-winning, registered charitable, community theatre group and performing arts school. Marquee is located in Aurora, Ontario. As this is a community theatre production: **all roles are non-equity/non-paying. There is no fee to audition.**

Membership Fee and Volunteer Hour Requirement:

Marquee Theatrical Productions has an initial annual membership fee** of \$25/person. There is an additional \$10 production fee for each production you are in. Total Membership fee is \$35 **DUE ONLY IF YOU ARE CAST IN THE SHOW.** Everyone cast in our productions is required to pay this fee.

*The membership fee offsets costume cleaning, provides professional Directors, Music Directors, Choreographers and Costume Builders for each show. You are not required to sell a certain number of tickets or to supply your own costumes other than shoes and personal undergarments, or potential items you may already have in your closet at home.

Putting on this show takes a village. There are many parts to putting a show together and, as a charitable organization, we rely on volunteers to help in many areas (painting sets, assisting with props, costumes, admin, marketing, cleaning etc.). **If you are cast in this production, an agreement on your part is also expected;** to volunteer 10 hours to Marquee leading up to opening night.

If you are unable to fulfill this obligation, you have the opportunity to choose to make a \$125 donation to Marquee and we will issue you a charitable donation tax receipt for this amount as your contribution toward the show. Volunteer hours may be performed by an adult friend or family member or by you yourself.

In addition to our marketing initiatives, we ask that you will like and share our social media posts about the show and spread the word to family and friends.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Near the beginning of rehearsals we will be taking costume measurements and taking headshots. We will also be doing an interview series to create a buzz around this exciting production!
